Notes:

- (1) The applicant is required to follow the above steps in sequence. The Academic Registry will notify the units involved when all the steps are completed.
- (2) # The applicant must pay up all the water and electricity charges, empty your room, return the hostel key to the Hostel Management Office of lived building, and bring the "Notice of Departure" when you come to the Students' Learning Communities Development Team.
- According to the government regulation (Guangdong [2007] Reference No. 129, Item No.4), the refund to students who withdraw or terminate their studies for any reasons will be based on the following calculation: The Refundable= (tuition/year+ hostel fee/year)/10 academic months*(One academic year is divided into 10 academic months). No refund will be processed until all the clearance procedures are officially settled. For students who have paid up front but quit at the beginning without taking any classes, 90% of the tuition and hostel fees will be refunded.
- (4) To avoid unnecessary financial loss, students are strongly advised to finish all the clearance procedures within the month when the withdrawal/leave of absence application is officially approved.
